Judy related that the Congress was continuing to move forward on legislation affecting the gag rule. The Senate had approved the Labor/HHS Appropriations bill by a vote of 78 to 22 but with a parental notification for minors abortion amendment that was very troubling. The bill would now move to a House/Senate Conference Committee. Judy reported that the Association had hired Fred Thompson, Esq., as counsel to aid us in discussions with the Administration. Negotiations are in progress between [REDACTED] and the White House to try and reach a compromise on the HHS regulations. NFPRHA has played an active, behind the scenes, part in the negotiations along with PFFA.
