December 14-16, 2007

Results are based on telephone interviews with –1,011—national adults, aged 18+, conducted December 14-16, 2007. For results based on the total sample of national adults, one can say with 95% confidence that the margin of sampling error is ± 3 percentage points.

In addition to sampling error, question wording and practical difficulties in conducting surveys can introduce error or bias into the findings of public opinion polls.
